# Which is it? Baroque or Classical era Game

#### **Before You Play:**

- 1. Print and cut the cards.
- 2. You may laminate them or print them on cardstock.

#### **Rules:**

- 1. Break the class into two equal groups (Group A and Group B).
- 2. Let each group pick their team name and write the team names on the board.
- 3. Mix the cards up.
- 4. Show the class one card at a time. Ask them, "Which is it? Baroque or Classical Era? (Show and read the card aloud.)
- 5. Give each group 10-30 seconds to find the answer between them. You can use a timer or count out loud.
- 6. Select a spokesman to answer for Group A. If they answer correctly, add a point. If they answer incorrectly, ask Group B for the answer.
- 7. Repeat the steps for the next card, giving Group B the first turn to answer, and so forth.
